

What	Can You	Do during Formation Hour?
Age/grade	Room	Focus
6 weeks to 3 years old	Nursery	Stories, music and lots of play time with trained staff and volunteers.
3 and young 4 year olds <u>Tots</u>	Room 3 of Day School	Tot's learn about God's love for them and learn formational Bible stories. Music, art and play are an important part of this group.
4-5 year olds <u>Godly Play</u>	Children's Chapel	Godly Play introduces Bible stories using the Montessori method of wonder and discovery through storytelling and play.
Kindergarden-5 <sup>th</sup> grade <u>Sparks</u>	Rooms 1, 2, 4 in the Day School	Our Sparks program digs a bit deeper into foundational Bible stories. Art and Music are an important part as well.
6 <sup>th</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> grade <u>The Gang</u>	Conference Rm 2	Our Faith Weavers program is carefully designed to engage, enlighten and deepen faith.
9 <sup>th</sup> and 10 <sup>th</sup> Grade <u>Seekers</u>	Conference Rm 1B	In depth discussion of what it means to be a Christian today. Film clips, music and small group discussions are the format.
11 <sup>th</sup> and 12 <sup>th</sup> grade <u>Disciples</u>	Conference Rm 1 A	This group has two programs. Year 1 is Confirmation. Year 2 is a Ministry Internship. Small group discussion, film clips and music are also used.

What is there	For adults	During Formation Hour?
Alf	Parish Hall	Adults less than 50 gather for fellowship and discussion. Led by skilled lay leaders.
Jump Start	Runs 3 times per year in the church	5 week introduction to the Episcopal Church and life at Emmanuel. Led by Clergy.
Adult Forum	Sanctuary/Narthex	More in depth discussion of faith, contemporary issues in society from a Christian perspective. Led by skilled lay leaders.
Bible Synthesis	Library	In depth discussion of the scriptures for the day. Led by skilled lay leaders.
